CERTIFICATION

Certification is a process in which your child becomes eligible to participate. Certification usually takes place around second weekend of August and is performed historically at Cecil Field. Your child **MUST** attend Certification and all required documents must be in order. Once your teams documents have found to be in order then the team will proceed to be weighed-in (expect cheerleaders) and a photo will be taken for ID purposes. Your child (football only) must meet the weight category for his/her age, if your child is not going to make weight on Certification, then he/she will have one more opportunity at Jamboree the following week. If he/she fails at Cecil Field or Jamboree, he/she will not be allowed to participate and no refund will be issued.

The following documents are required for each participant prior to August 1st (exception 3B Form). If ANY of the following documents are missing he/she will not be allowed to practice. NO EXCEPTIONS.

FEES

****All football fees must be paid in full by 7/22/2010****

Football Registration Fee **\$160** Includes: Game jersey and socks (not returned after the season), game pants (returned at end of season), Pop Warner Registration, insurance, picture identification, equipment refurbishing, and patches.

****All cheer fees must be paid in full by 7/1/2010****

Cheerleading Registration Fee: **\$250** (Tiny & Mitey mites); **\$300** (Jr. Pee Wee to Midget)
Includes: Shell, skirt, midriff, bloomers, socks (competition), shoes (competition), practice uniform (T-shirt & shorts), hairpiece, competition hair bow, Pop Warner Registration, insurance, picture identification, and patches.

REFUNDS

There is a \$50 non-refundable deposit for football and cheerleading fees. This deposit goes towards registration fee, securing a position on a team and equipment. There are **no refunds** at all for football after August 6, 2010 or cheerleading after fittings.

FUNDRAISING AND WHY

The following divisions fundraise for their end-of-year party and/or trophies: Tiny Mite and Mitey Mite. These divisions are not eligible for playoff or championship games; therefore they have no travel expenses.

The following divisions for both Football and Cheerleading are eligible for playoffs and championships: Jr. Pee Wee, Pee Wee, Jr. Midget, and Midget. These championships require travel out-of-town in most cases and can become very expensive for parents. This is why we fundraise – to stay out of your pocket as much as possible. By participating in fundraisers as a team, any money raised is used to help the team with expenses. Failure to participate in/at team fundraisers will result in an average amount raised, for the fundraiser, to be paid by the parent.

We have found that fundraising in that manner works very well. It is the practice of some Associations not to fundraise or even coordinate fundraising efforts. They simply say, “You can’t pay, you can’t play.” WFL does not support this, as we feel no child should be denied the opportunity to advance due to ones “financial status”. After all, this is about them, their hard work, commitments, and struggles to achieve his/her championship.

We also have park-wide fundraisers each season that requires the help of all WFL participants to help cover expenses for the park such as phone, concession, refurbishing and ordering new equipment. WFL is a non-profit organization. It is necessary to raise money to pay park bills and upkeep. We thank you in advance for your support.
